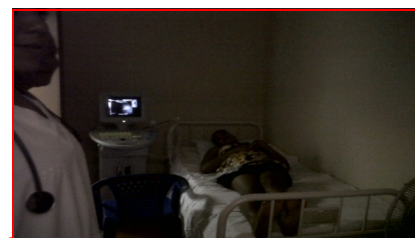
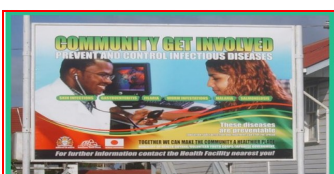


Equipping hospitals for the Future.

Volunteer Youth Corps Inc continues its support to two regional hospitals in regions 5 and 7. The organization just recently completed a visit with two Japanese Officers to review the conditions of the medical equipment donated to Hospitals in September 2008. Equipment includes: Autoclaves, Microscopes, Ultra-sounds and centrifuges. At both hospitals, VYC officers were most impressed that all the equipment except one were in top functioning order. The Japanese Grassroots Human Security Project was spearheaded by Volunteer Youth Corps in 2008 in partnership with Ministry of Health. The project was implemented under two phases: equipping hospitals to respond early to infectious diseases and secondly to increase awareness in treatment options, and as well as lay the basis for disease control and eradication. The organization was able to collaborate with 12 indigenous communities within the Essequibo, Cuyuni and Mazaruni rivers.
